School Car Parks

We are trying to restrict the movement of cars at busy periods but often visitors on official business could be leaving the school at this time. The only parents who should be using the car parks for dropping off and collection of their children should be those who have been granted access for disability reasons and received a parking permit. They should use the car park above the main office or the disabled bays.

The safety and wellbeing of our pupils is our utmost priority and we would appreciate your support to make sure our site is as safe as possible. Thank you.

Headlice

We have head lice in school again. Please be vigilant and check your child's hair regularly.

The signs that you or your child may have head lice is they make your head feel itchy and like something is moving in your hair. Treat head lice as soon as you spot them and check everyone in the house, also treat them the same day if they have head lice. Head lice can be removed by wet combing. This method should be tried first. You can buy a special fine toothed comb online or from any pharmacy.

- Use the comb on wet or dry hair (works better on wet with conditioner)
- Comb the whole head of hair from roots to the ends
- Repeat every few days for 2 weeks
- It usually takes around 10 minutes to comb short hair and 20 to 30 minutes for long or curly hair.

Ask your pharmacist for advice if you have tried wet combing for 2 weeks, but your child still has head lice.

They may recommend using medicated lotions or sprays. These kill head lice in all types of hair, and you can buy them from any pharmacy, supermarket or online. Head lice should die within one day of using this. Some treatments need to be repeated after a week to kill any newly hatched lice. If lotions or sprays don't work speak to your pharmacist about other treatments.
