Parental consultations will take place from Monday 26th February. Teachers will be sending out letters next week detailing the exact date for your child's class and allowing you to select an appointment time.

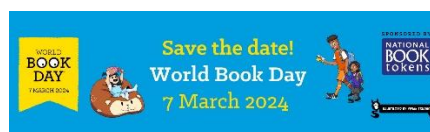
World Book Day – Thursday 7th March
